Dear Friends.

By now, many of you may have heard of or watched the devastation caused by the Taal Volcano eruption in the Philippines.

Thick layer of heavy ash covers homes, businesses, vegetation and animals in black mud in several towns and provinces around Taal. About 125,000 people fled their homes in hardest-hit Batangas province and surrounding areas, about 40 miles south of Manila. Most of the population in the affected areas have lost their means of livelihood as farmers and fishermen.

More importantly, their health is compromised by the inhalation of ash, chemicals and exposure to diseases spread in a crowded space. Over 250 evacuation sites are crammed with the displaced and are in need of personal and hygiene supplies and materials such as face masks (N95), basic medicine, tooth brushes, family size toothpaste and soap.

Aid is requested to purchase bigger items such as water filters, kitchen stoves, recyclable plates and utensils, sanitizing and other products that could substitute and eliminate environmental wastes such as Styrofoam plates & cups, and plastic bags used at relocation centers.

We appeal to you, to please help the Philippine Cultural and Civic Center Foundation (PCCCF), raise funds for people severely impacted by the calamity.
